



CTAP Technology Academies Trainer of Trainers Institute (ToTI)

LACOE's Instructional Technology Outreach division has opened registration for this summer's CTAP Technology Academies Trainer of Trainers Institute. Teachers attending this week-long training will be certified to redeliver both the CTAP Level 1 and Level 2 curriculum.

Who: Institute is open to all district certificated personnel. Participants will be chosen by their consortium or school district. Participants selected are expected to redeliver CTAP Level 1 or Level 2 Academy curriculum at the local level.

What: The Trainer of Trainers Institute includes a week-long residency training and a five-day internship commitment. At the ToTI, participants will work with experienced CTAP presenters and receive in-depth training in the delivery of, and the pedagogy behind, the Level 1 and Level 2 curriculum. Participants will also receive training on presentation skills and adult learning theory. Upon completion of the residency training, participants will co-present a Level 1 or Level 2 academy along with an experienced CTAP presenter who will act as their coach/mentor for this training. After completion of the ToTI program, LACOE will continue to provide resources and ongoing mentor support for ToTI graduates.

When: The week-long residency training is Sunday, July 27 – Friday, August 1, 2008. The internship can be completed anytime between August, 2008 and July, 2009.

Where: The week-long residency training is at the Thacher School in Ojai, California. The internship requirement can be fulfilled at any Level 1 or Level 2 academy scheduled by LACOE CTAP or by any consortium or school district.

Why: The CTAP 11 Regional Governance Council saw a need for increased capacity to train teachers in personal proficiency and technology integration skills. They also saw a need for greater flexibility for the consortia and school districts in scheduling technology training.

How Much: CTAP 11 will be completely underwriting the cost of the ToTI. Participants pay nothing for the week-long residency at the Thacher School in Ojai. In addition, they will receive a \$500 stipend from CTAP upon completion of that week and a \$500 stipend upon completion of their intern week.

How to Apply: The ToTI is limited to 30 teachers. Each consortium is eligible to send at least two teachers. Names of teachers chosen by the consortium should be submitted by Friday, March 14, 2008 to:
